Contributions for the month of June have increased significantly \$16, 379 nearly double the budgeted amount of \$8610. This offsets losses in the previous two months and brings year to date contributions to within 3% of budget. Literature sales are down 28% to the budget, however year to date sales are 4% over budget.

Both cost of sales and expenses are below budget by 25% and 28% respectively. Overall, for the month there is a surplus of \$5,202 vs. a budgeted deficit of \$6,155.

The ORC 2025 attendance was down this year from last year by 200 attendees.

Early this year we saw prices rising in our economy.

Also, this year in July the International Convention was held in Vancouver.

The result was that people made decisions on how they were going to spend their money & where.

This year we changed the Audio-Visual (A/V) Company "ENCORE" because the last few years the sound was not good.
