Contributions although considerably better than last month continue to be below budget by 44%. Literature sales are also below budget by 14% but are comparable to May 2024. Total revenue for May was \$14,791 or 27% below budget.

Cost of Sales for the month is better than budgeted by \$1,500 or 15%, also expenses are well below budget due to some expenses budgeted for May being paid in April.

Overall, the deficit for May is \$1,924 vs a budgeted amount of \$11,162.
